Important Notes : "Grant with Conditions:- 1) The school is required to obtain Recognition Certificate at least up to class VIII, issued by concerned State Education Department as per extant rules and provisions in RTE act-2009 and upload a copy in the mandatory public disclosure link on the school website. 2) Building Safety Certificate has not been found as per norms as it has been issued in the name of society instead of school name. School authority is therefore, required to obtain a valid copy of Building Safety Certificate, in the name of school issued by Competent Govt. Authority of concerned department (PWD) or issued by govt empanelled engineer along with copy of license issued by competent govt authority. The copy of Building Safety Certificate along with copy of license (in case of empanelled engineer) is required to be uploaded in the public disclosure on the school website as per Appendix IX of affiliation bye laws. 3) Fire Safety Certificate submitted by the school is not issued by the appropriate authority (issued by Gram Panchayat Development Officer) and the stamp of issuing authority is in vernacular language. Hence, School is required to obtain fire safety certificate issued by the Fire Safety Department of the State/UT of appropriate government authority with Seal of issuing authority in Hindi or English language. The same is required to be uploaded in the public disclosure link on the school website as per Appendix IX of affiliation bye laws. 4) School is required to appoint a Special Educator in the school as per norms. 5) Geo Tag image, Infrastructure photos (library, labs, playground, toilets, school

building etc.) have not been uploaded in Part B uploads. Video is also not found functional." School is required to appoint wellness teacher as per affiliation bye laws.

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
